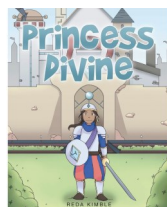

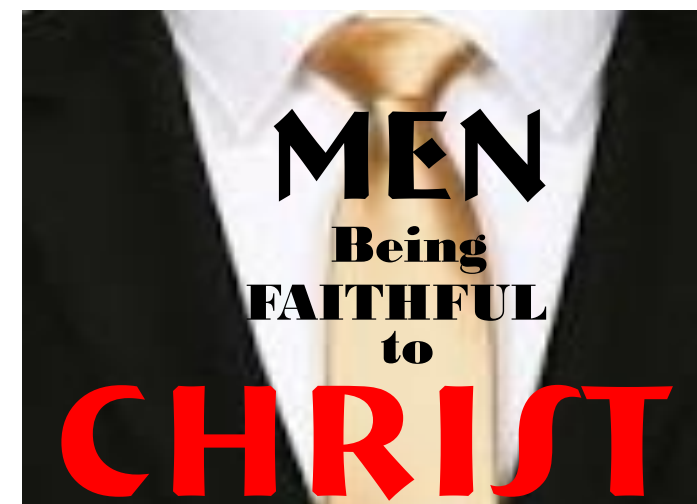

## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH Minister Roswell Lawrence, Jr.



Minister Roswell Lawrence, Jr. is a native of Greene County, growing up just outside of Greensboro, Ga. A licensed and ordained preacher, his ministerial calling has allowed him to serve in many capacities. He has served as an Adjunct Religion Professor, Dean of Christian Education, Youth Minister & Director of the Youth Department, Church Financial Adviser and Armor-bearer to the Senior Pastor among other roles.

Roswell is proud of being a product of the Greene County Public School System. He furthered his education at the University of Georgia, receiving a Bachelors’ degree in Business with an emphasis in Accounting, and he earned a Master’s of Business Administration focusing on Financial Services from Piedmont College. He also has a Master’s of Divinity degree in Pastoral Care from Luther Rice University & Seminary. Reverend Lawrence is presently a Ph.D. Candidate in Educational Administration and Policy at the University of Georgia. His research focuses on the recruitment and retention of African American students at predominately White research intensive (R1) institutions along with the associated financial resources.

Currently, Roswell is employed with the University of Georgia as Assistant to the Vice President for Finance & Administration and Director of Client Relations. In this role, he is responsible for providing communication support for all 10 Finance and Administration units while being a liaison to the academic, research and student life areas of the university.

Reverend Lawrence serves on the board of directors for the Athens-Clarke County Mentor Program, volunteers with the Kairos Prison Ministry International and is an active member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated and Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity. He is also the founder of the Lawrence Foundation, an organization that helps young people reach their dreams by enhancing their mind, body and soul, while empowering their families with the skills to support them.

Roswell Lawrence, Jr. has a servant’s heart, an excellent work ethic, and inspiring ambition. He is married to his lovely wife, Tionya and they have one child, Roswell III. Their home for spiritual growth is at the East Friendship Baptist Church in Athens, Georgia with Pastor James Kendrick.
